SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS
FROM THE AMERICAN WOMEN'S CLUB IN DENMARK

The American Women's Club in Denmark announces scholarship awards to be awarded to Danish women for graduate studies (videregaende uddannelse) in the United States for a term of at least three months. Awarded once every three years, these scholarships are intended for students who are not presently studying in the United States.

Applicants must provide the following documents with their applications:

(Additional pages may be attached. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications must be typewritten and **in English.**)

1. Completed American Women's Club Scholarship Application.
2. A statement of purpose written by the applicant, describing her educational goals and how a scholarship would benefit her.
3. Letters of reference from at least 2 different sources. (*One letter **MUST** be from a teacher or other academic professional. Additional letter(s) can come from any other non-academic professional including employers and/or clergy.)
4. A transcript of university (or equivalent) grades.
5. Documentation of admission to (or invitation from) an accredited graduate school in the United States for the 2006 academic year. If her program involves extensive travel, an itinerary showing confirmed arrangements.
6. A budget of her university expenses including tuition, travel and housing plus her financial support sources such as loans and scholarships.
